

Village of Moreauville
Town Council Meeting
August 20, 2026

On Thursday, August 20, 2026, the Mayor and Board of Alderman met in regular session at the Moreauville Town Hall at 6:00 p.m.

Present: Mayor Beryl Holmes, Alderman Timothy Hill, Alderman Farrell Johnson, and Alderman Shannon Sampson

The meeting opened with a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Timothy Hill, seconded by Farrell Johnson to approve July 13, 2026, minutes as printed. M/C

Motion by Farrell Johnson, seconded by Timothy Hill to approve the July 2026 bills for payment. M/C
Jacob Gauthier of Pan American Engineers updated the mayor and council of the WWTP Rehabilitation Phase 1-FY24 LCDBG, contractors expect to have enough material and equipment on hand to begin construction around mid-October. LDEQ-Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Project No. 2-WWTP Rehabilitation (Phase 2), Pan American is in the process of gathering fully executed contract documents for schedule of the preconstruction conference. For the Sewer Pump Station Rehabilitation (Water Sector-Phase 2) and the Mayeux Street Sidewalk Rahab (HB 460). Contractor will return to the Village to complete this work on Friday, August 21, 2026, or Monday, August 24, 2026. PAE recommends accepting the project as substantially complete.

Jacob Guillory of Delta Engineering Group informed the mayor and council that two bids were received for the CWEF South Bayou Des Glaisses Road water main replacement project. Womack and Sons Construction was the lower bidder and recommended the project be awarded to Womack and Sons Construction Group contingent upon a deductive change order to reduce the project scope to within the \$37,725.00 available for construction. The FY 24/25 LGAP security cameras are being handled by the Village, with Assistant Police Chief Derrick Ward Coordinating. Delta Engineering Group is still awaiting awards for the FY25/26 LGAP & CWEF, which will replace a portion of the 2-inch water main along Couvillion Street from Rico Road near the railroad heading north. Award announcements are expected in September. They are also awaiting the award for the second NGDISM gas grant which they submitted in May. Award announcements are expected in October. The paving of Carol Street and Lougarre Street is expected to begin in October.

Kirk Lacour, candidate for District Judge Division B introduced himself, outlined his candidacy and asked everyone in attendance for their support.

Kacey Meche addressed the Mayor and council on opening an accounting/bookkeeping/tax business in Moreauville. Mayor Holmes and council welcomed Kacey's new business.

Motion by Farrell Johnson, seconded by Shannon Sampson to adopt the Substantial-Complete Resolution for the Mayeux Street Sidewalk Rehabilitation. M/C

Motion by Timothy Hill, seconded by Farrell Johnson to adopt the Commit Local Funds and Select Delta Regional Authority Resolution. M/C

Motion by Timothy Hill, seconded by Farrell Johnson to adopt a Resolution to select engineer. Pan American Engineers was selected. M/C.

Motion by Farrell Johnson, seconded by Shannon Sampson to adopt the CWEF Resolution for the Main Water Replacement on South Bayou Des Glaisses Road. M/C

Motion by Timothy Hill, seconded by Shannon Sampson to approve payment to the Feliciana Welders invoice for \$32,750.00 for gas leak repairs along Main Street. M/C

Motion by Shannon Sampson, seconded by Timothy Hill to accept the utility report given by Superintendent Norris Lemoine. M/C

Motion by Farrell Johnson, seconded by Shannon Sampson, to accept the police report given by Assistant Chief Derrick Ward. M/C

Motion by Farrell Johnson, seconded by Timothy Hill to accept and approve the July 2026 financial report M/C

Motion by Shannon Sampson, seconded by Timothy Hill to add police officer Taronda Jacobs to the agenda. M/C

The Village of Moreauville police department hired Taronda Jacob on July 17, 2026, as a full time officer, starting pay of \$18.00 per hour.

Having no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned upon a motion by Timothy Hill and seconded by Farrell Johnson. M/C
