From Mayor Beryl Holmes



We are excited to share the many improvements happening throughout our community.

During the 2021 year, the Mayor and Council applied for a \$75,000 Louisiana Community Development Block Grant, a capital outlay request. The grant was awarded and the VOM will match it with \$25,000 for this project. The LCDBG funding is strictly dedicated to the sidewalk project from the state. This will repair and replace approximately 1.25 miles of damaged sidewalks. The estimated cost for the sidewalk project is \$100,000.

Recently, three streets were resurfaced in the VOM. These streets are Mayeaux, Dufour and Rita. The project was funded through Road District II tax monies. Another LCDBG grant worth \$800,000, for road improvements, was applied for and unfortunately was denied. Future projects are also in the works for the upcoming season with monies from Road District II as well.

Currently, we are in the process of submitting a LCDBG application for 2023-2024 for renovations or building onto our sewage treatment plant. In the past, the current administration, submitted two applications for LCDBG grants. Unfortunately, they were not awarded, along with two Water Sector Program applications which were also not awarded. We will continue to pursue any other avenues to address the sewer system problem.

During the month of July, the Farmers' Market was held twice. We are thankful to our local community members for participating and making it a great success!

In other news, it was such a pleasure to be able to supply over 300 students, at our Back to School Bash, with backpacks and supplies to start the new school year! Thanks to our wonderful sponsors! (listed on page 2)
